Implementation of 6% GST by Malaysian Government for Tours & Services and the collection of 6% GST by Wah Tung Travel Service Sdn Bhd

The Malaysian government has announced that start from 1st April 2015, Goods and Services Tax (GST) will be implemented at the rate of six (6) percent. This would mean that starting from 1st April 2015, under Malaysian Law, all inbound tour and hotel packages & other services that are consumed in Malaysia are subject to 6% GST. This also applies to bookings made before 1st April 2015 but a service is supplied on/after 1st April 2015.

As a company registered under GST, we would like to inform our valued clients that GST will be added at the prevailing rate to all invoices.

What is GST?

GST is known as Goods and Services tax or value added tax (VAT) in many countries. It is a multi-stage consumption tax on goods and services. Tax will be levied on the supply of goods and services at each stage of the supply chain from the supplier up to the retail stage of the distribution.
